Most of the day

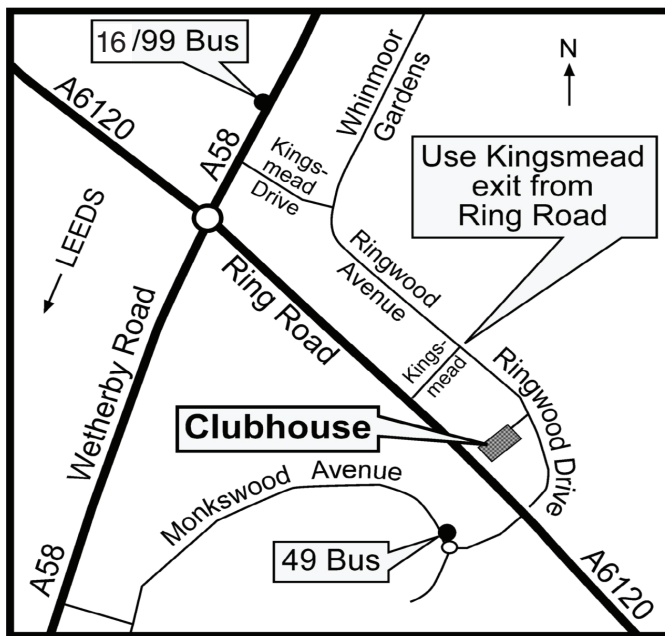

How to find us

By car

From the East: from the York Road (A64) Junction with Leeds Ring Road (A6120) at Seacroft, follow the ring road west approx 1 mile and turn right into Kingsmead and right again into Ringwood Drive.

From the West: follow Leeds Ring Road (A6120). Just after the junction with the Wetherby road (A58) turn left into Kingsmead, then right into Ringwood Drive. *Access to the venue is via narrow driveway on the right.*

By bus

Bus service 49 (Bramley-Leeds, Eastgate-Monkswood Gate) terminates only 3 minutes walk from the venue. From bus terminus, walk about 50 yards to ring road, cross it and enter Ringwood Drive. *Access to the venue is via narrow driveway on the left. Bus journey times from Leeds Eastgate: 25 - 30 mins. Last buses back to Leeds Friday evening: 22:40, 23:10*

Bus service X99 (Leeds - Wetherby) passes along the Wetherby road, 7 mins walk from venue. From first stop Wetherby side of Leeds Ring Road, enter Kingsmead Drive (Londis shop on corner). Bear right into Ringwood Avenue/Drive. *Access to the venue is via narrow driveway on the right. Bus journey times from Leeds Infirmary Street near railway station: 25 - 30 mins. Last buses back to Leeds Friday evening: 22:58, 23:58*
